**CHANGES IN CLASS - IX**

- 'Computational Thinking & Artificial Intelligence' has been introduced for class IX from the current session. Exams for this subject will be school-based and twice a year.
- Art Education for class IX will now include Visual Art, Music, Dance & Theatre. Exams for this subject will be school-based and twice a year.
- Financial Literacy will be a skill subject for class IX.

**A few words to parents as we approach summer break**

- Parents are requested to monitor the screen time of students. Students should study, complete their homework and other assignments on time. Extra time should be used for creative pursuits like hobby classes, reading books, playing games, etc. Students can also hone their technical skills by enrolling in online AI classes.
- Students of higher classes must avoid social media. They should have no social media presence as it affects their studies, wastes time and creates unnecessary distraction. Online or video games should also be avoided.
- It was observed that some students were extremely irregular during online classes. Teachers have taken classes online, conducted doubt-clearing and completed the syllabus for TT-1. Students need to be serious and regular.
